**THE PIVOT TOWARDS
DECARBONIZATION & SUSTAINABLE MINING**

To achieve a 1.5° C climate-change target by 2050, the mining industry would have to reduce direct CO2 emissions to zero. To do so, industry players need to start early & decisively pivot towards decarbonisation of industrial processes.

Vedanta Group is one such early starter and prioritising sustainability, has set for itself a target of reducing carbon footprint by 30% by 2030, and achieve 'net zero' by 2070.

DECARBONIZATION IN MOTION

To achieve the targets set out as part of its decarbonization strategy, Sesa Goa has identified actions at multiple levels to address the principal sources of emissions and to decarbonize effectively & within acceptable target timelines. Such actions include a move toward sustainable sourcing, fuels, and electric HEMMs, as well as a switch to green electricity. The following options are at varying states of technological readiness; several are already cost-positive today or will be in coming years:

'Green' electricity: Switching to a green source of electricity addresses between 30–50% of current emissions output and is a must if electrifying processes is the chosen path to decarbonization. Several alternatives at different levels of complexity are available, from 100% shift to renewable energy (RE) sources, to purchasing 'green' electricity, and to entering into power purchase agreements with RE producing vendors.

Affecting the necessary shift in strategy, Sesa Goa's wholly owned subsidiary WCL (Western Cluster Limited) in Liberia, which is going for aggressive expansion and will have a power requirement of more than 400 MW in the next 5 years, prefers to go all-green and working to cater this power requirement through RE-RTC source. Similarly, Vedanta's Iron Ore Karnataka - A. Narrain mines are going for RE-Power Purchase Agreement to cater to its majority power requirement through RE sources.

Sustainable machinery: To go fully diesel-free, a shift in drive trains is required, with both battery-operated electric vehicles (BEVs) and hydrogen fuel cells being possible long-term options. Vedanta Sesa Goa has made a shift by on-boarding and deploying electric vehicles (EVs) including Electric Wheel Loaders in their Iron ore mining operations, as also commenced the process of inducting EV passenger vehicles.

Charles Dias, head coach of Sesa Football Academy, is determined to turn around the fortunes of his team as they prepare for the I-League 3. The Academy will compete in Group B, hosted at the Dempo Academy Ground in Goa. Their group includes Kerala United FC, Garhwal FC, and Dalbir FA. Having faced relegation from I-League 2 last season on the final day of the competition, Maharashtra Orange will look to bank on the experiences of last season and would be eager to get back into I-League 3. Dias believes his side have the potential to put up a good show. "The most important thing for us at this stage is to give the boys an idea of the way we want to play so that they can ensure that on

the pitch," he said. Having analysed the recent friendly games, Dias said they play an attacking game and urged his team to play in a "compact manner". "I believe from the bottom of my heart that these boys can perform on that stage against those teams," the coach said. Dias said he wants his team to let their performances do the talking after gaining experience from various friendly matches. "It's always important to play as many preparatory matches as possible. We played so many friendlies before the I-League 3, and you can see the results. The team was playing as a cohesive unit and played an attractive, attacking brand of football. That does not happen in one day," he said. "Winning seven matches in a row in the Goa Pro League and Professional League teams is
