Vedanta inaugurates 'Jivika' tailoring training centre to empower women from Chitradurga District

 Vedanta's CSR initiative will benefit women from across 4 villages from Chitradurga district

Chitradurga, 26 February, 2022: Vedanta's Iron Ore Karnataka (IOK) recently inaugurated tailoring training centre at Bheemasamudra village, reaching out to aspiring women from across 4 villages in Chitradurga district. As a part of 'Jivika' project- A CSR initiative of Vedanta's IOK, a first tailoring training centre is started, to provide skill development opportunities for the women wherein 30+ women enrolled in first batch. The 'Jivika' Tailoring Training centre at Bheemasamudra was inaugurated in the distinguished presence of GP President, Parvatamma along with Vedanta's staff.

This initiative is a part of Vedanta IOK's umbrella CSR initiative in collaboration with NGO partner BAIF, that is Alternative Livelihood Opportunities Project (ALOP). Aim of 'Jivika' program is to foster women Self-Help Groups (SHGs) activities and provide the quality skill training to women for generation of sustainable livelihood opportunities for them. Women from surrounding communities can enrol for two months tailoring training program at this centre and will be awarded certificate upon successful completion of the course.
