# Vedanta provides Infrastructure support to Chitradurga District Administration.

- Donates two high tech computer desktops to the Police Department at Chitradurga.

**Chitradurga, 12<sup>th</sup> January 2022:** In order to support upgradation of infrastructure at Chitradurga district administration offices, Vedanta's Iron Ore Karnataka Business has recently provided two high-tech desktops to the district police department and installed a 250-litres capacity water filter with 125 litres per hour RO System along with a protective mesh, at the tahsildar office. The objective of these initiatives is to provide the facilities to the staff of district administration and to people from Chitradurga district who visits these offices.

The water filter with RO system will provide access to safe and clean drinking water to over 300 individuals on average every day, from Chitradurga district. Newly installed water facility was inaugurated by the Assistant Commissioner and Sub Divisional Magistrate of Chitradurga subdivision, Mr. R. Chandraiah in the presence of G. H Sathyanarayana, Tahsildar, Chitradurga.

The high- tech desktops will support the local police department by enabling them to serve the people using technologies & advance digital platforms.
